- Is also expected to have raised new questions about the field;
- Will have indicated avenues for further exploration in her area of study;
- Will have gained both extensive and intensive knowledge of her field of study.

In addition, the programme will have enabled the development of skills such as

- close reading;
- critical thinking;
- analytical/theoretical rigour;
- precise, cohesive and lucid writing.

The course work is designed keeping these objectives and outcomes in mind.
