

PhD syllabus

The PhD programme in English requires the researcher to complete course work for 16 credits. If she has not completed an M.Phil from the Department it is mandatory for her to do the Research Methods and Critical Approaches courses, each for four credits. In addition she must also complete the Research and Publication Ethics course for two credits as mandated by the UGC. The researcher must also complete other courses pertaining to her topic for another six credits, and the entire coursework is to be completed within a year.

Research Methods: 4 credits

Critical Approaches: 4 credits (*mandatory for all those who have not completed an MPhil from the Department of English at the University of Hyderabad*)

Research and Publication Ethics: 2 Credits
